- Infrastructures, projects and funding cycles
 - Both EU and USA
- Different nature of Infrastructures
 - EOSC versus EGI
 - Policies, trust, risks
- Importance of operational security, threat intelligence, SOCs, ...
- Federated identity ever more important (FIM4R, REFEDS)
 - Assurance requirements
- Policies and building trust continues to evolve
 - AARC PDK and policy templates
