Council Conclusions on Research Infrastructures

“ESFRI and EOSC Steering Board are independent Commission Expert Groups and closely coordinate with and regularly inform the ERA Forum;”

“The Council of the European Union, **UNDERLINES** the role of ESFRI in triggering and structuring coordinated approaches at both European and national levels to the RI policy-making, resulting in, among others, roadmapping and landscaping processes, leading to a more coherent RI policy-making in Europe; in this respect, **CONSIDERS that the coordination between ESFRI and the European Open Science Cloud (EOSC) Steering Board is needed; ...**”

ESFRI-EOSC Task Force Objectives

- ensure a structured interface between the ESFRI Forum and the EOSC Steering Board beyond the current ad-hoc cooperation
- facilitate common and/or complementary strategies for the further uptake of open science practices and the further deployment of the FAIR principles, as well as the accelerated connection of the research infrastructures included in the ESFRI roadmaps and the ERICs in the EOSC federation and the uptake of EOSC horizontal services by these research infrastructures

- Increased alignment of the operation of ESFRI in function of the deployment of the EOSC Core and Exchange

- Assist with joint ESFRI-EOSC events

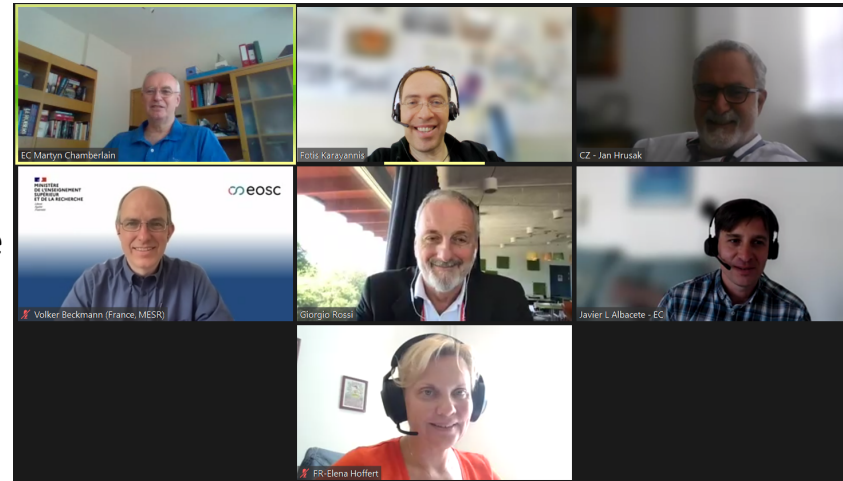
