## Data policy to save decades

In Buenos Aires, the data for importing, exporting and correct interoperability of academic years and subjects approved in other South American countries to be validated in the Argentine Republic are not harmonized. For this reason, administrative processes have been accelerated in order not to stagnate the development of individuals from various Latin communities. Bolivians, Peruvians, Venezuelans; generally, they must study at least 4 years to enter the University. Most of them speak Spanish/Castilian perfectly. The majority of ministerial officials do not activate or perfect the metadata system to validate the academic qualifications of young people and adults. From my position, pressure is exerted for the automation of international educational procedures taking into account the DDI standard.
