The following new information now pertains to the electronic infrastructures in Greece:

Daidalus, the new Greek super-computer, has faced unfortunately long delays, and while it is operational, it is still not in the full production phase, due to physical space problems

AI factory: Already existing data will be transformed to be AI compatible starting in the following fields

(1) Health, (2) Culture and Language, (3) Sustainability

And will be directly connected with the following European actions: Digital Innovations Hubs, Competence centers, Digital Infrastructure Consortia, Data Spaces

The Project will participate in the European Commission Call of €1 billion “Digital Europe”.

New legislation on Cybersecurity: legislation is in the Greek parliament, with a plan to comply to the European guidelines NIS2
