1. Transport to Poznań

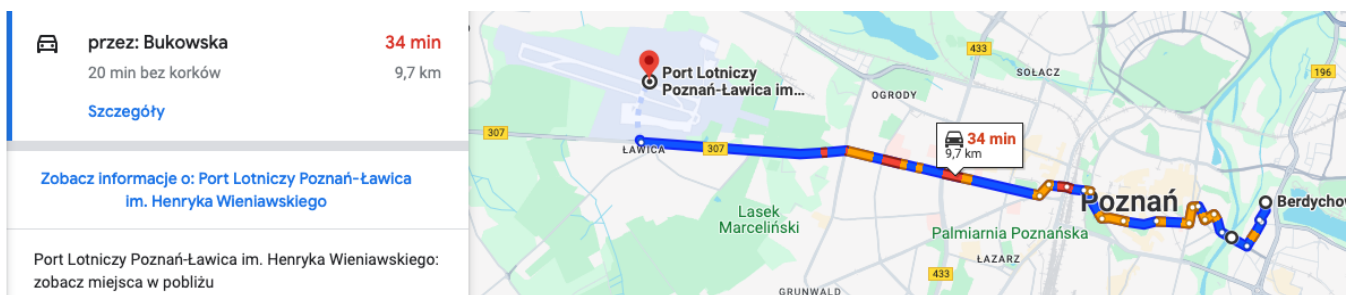
Poznań is well-connected to various parts of Europe through multiple modes of transportation:

1. **By Air:** Poznań-Ławica Henryk Wieniawski Airport (POZ) is located about 7 kilometers from the city center. It offers direct flights to major European cities such as Frankfurt, Brussels, Berlin, Paris, and Barcelona. The airport provides regular bus services to the city center, and taxis are readily available. 2. **By Train:** Poznań Main Station (Poznań Główny) is a major railway hub with connections to many European cities. Trains from Berlin, Frankfurt, and other major cities arrive at Poznań Główny, which is located on Głogowska Street. 3. **By Bus:** There are several bus services connecting Poznań to various European cities. The main bus station is located next to Poznań Główny, making it convenient for travelers arriving by bus. More information about bus connections available in Poland can be found here: <https://en.e-podroznik.pl/>

Distances from Key Locations to PCSS Headquarters

- **Poznań-Ławica Airport:** Approximately 7 kilometers from the PSNC headquarters at ul. Jana Pawła II 10.
- **Poznań Main Station:** Approximately 3 kilometers from the PSNC headquarters.

Takes about 20-40 minutes to get there, cab/taxi/uber/bolt has priority lanes.

2. Getting Around Poznań

2.1. Transport

2.1.1.1. Public Transport

- **Trams and Buses:** Poznań has an extensive network of trams and buses that cover the entire city. Tickets can be purchased at kiosks, online, or via a mobile app.
- **Tickets:** A single ticket costs around **6 PLN** and is valid for 45 minutes on trams and buses. More information about ticket prices can be found here (in Polish): <https://www.ztm.poznan.pl/wszystko-o-biletach/cennik-biletow/>
- **PROTIP:** There are several useful apps and websites to help you get around the city using public transport:
 - JakDojade (www.jakdojade.pl) - helps you plan your route, find the nearest bus or tram stops, and even tells you which ticket to buy. You can also buy and validate tickets within the app.

 - moBILET (www.mobilet.pl) - It allows you to purchase public transport tickets and pay for the parking.

2.1.1.2. Taxis

- **Taxis:** Taxis are widely available and can be easily found on the street in the city centre or booked via phone or app (Uber, Bolt, iTaxi). The cost of travel from the Ławica airport to PCSS is approximately **35 PLN** (Uber).
- **Use the yellow cabs (itaxi.pl)** just in front of the arrivals terminal exit- that's a good official cab company. They also have an app → <https://itaxi.pl/english/>
- Or Uber, Bolt - recommended **Comfort** option to get a safe ride. Please note there are mostly foreign drivers on uber/bolt with poor English, Polish understanding

2.1.1.3. Renting a Car

- **Car Rentals:** Several car rental companies operate in Poznań, including major international brands. Prices start at around **50 PLN per day**.

2.1.1.4. Walking and Cycling

- **Walking:** Poznań is a walkable city, especially the Old Town and the city center.
- **Cycling:** There are several bike rental services and dedicated bike lanes throughout the city.
- **Electric scooters:** Lime, Bolt, and Blink

2.2. Currency in Poland

Poland is not part of the Eurozone, so the official currency is the Polish zloty (PLN). However, the euro (EUR) is accepted in some tourist locations.

- **Currency Code:** PLN
- **Exchange Rate:** Approximately 1 EUR = 4.26 PLN (average rate)
- **Selling Rate:** 1 EUR = 4.29 PLN
- **Buying Rate:** 1 EUR = 4.21 PLN

2.3. Payment Methods

Payments by payment card and contactless are very popular in Poland, so most places, not only tourist ones, allow this form of payment. However, it is worth having small amounts of cash in Polish zlotys.

2.3.1.1. Card Payments

- **Credit and Debit Cards:** Major credit and debit cards such as Visa, MasterCard, and American Express are widely accepted in hotels, restaurants, and shops. It's always a good idea to carry a backup card in case one is not accepted.
- **Contactless Payments:** Many places also support contactless payments.

2.3.1.2. Cash Payments

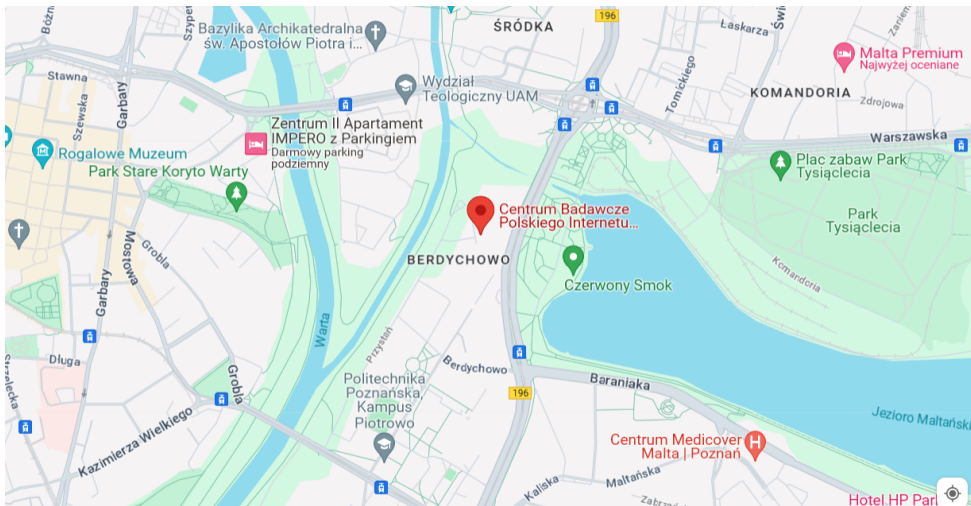
- **ATM Withdrawals:** ATMs are widely available and most accept international cards.
- **Currency Exchange:** Currency exchange offices ("Kantor") are common in cities and airports, offering reasonable rates. Currency exchange can also be done at banks and Polish Post offices.
